MEALS FOR STUDENTS IN THE BLENDED LEARNING EXPERIENCE

THUNCH WHEN AT SCHOOL

- Is provided daily for free
- Includes a minimum of 2 options (menu is available on our website, www.sd129.org/parents/school-meals)
- •Is selected by the student at school each day from those 2 options
- Is eaten at each student's desk (desks will be cleaned following lunch)
- Can be brought from home

*Please note that as students will be eating in their classrooms, it is critical that we are aware of any students who are susceptible to air-born food allergies so we can respond appropriately.

TITAKF-HOMF MFAIS

- Are intended to help fight food insecurity while students are learning from home
- Are provided for ALL students at the end of a day for free unless a parent opts out (form is included in this communication)

As an example, here is what a child attending on "A" days would receive during a typical week:

On **Friday**, the student would receive lunch at school as well as a meal packet containing:

Friday's dinner Monday's breakfast

*If a family requests it, we can also send home meals for Saturday and Sunday, or families may drive through any of our food distribution sites (during the week) to pick up weekend meals.

When utilizing our food distribution sites, you may pick up meals for multiple days to minimize trips. All packets will contain breakfast, lunch, and dinner and are available for any child within our community, regardless of whether or not they attend West Aurora schools.
